

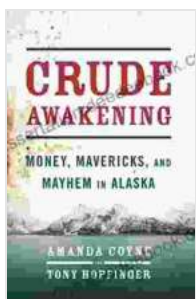
Crude Awakening: Money Mavericks And Mayhem In Alaska

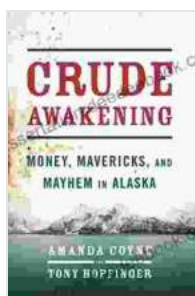
