
Malala Yousafzai

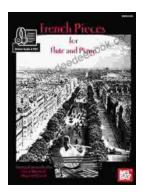
