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to Tunisian Crochet

- 3. Yo and draw through the first two loops on the hook.
- 4. Yo and draw through the remaining two loops on the hook.

Tunisian Full Stitch (tfs)

This stitch creates a dense and durable fabric with a subtle texture.

- 1. Make a tss as described above.
- 2. Yo and insert the hook into the vertical bar of the next stitch (the stitch below the tss).
- 3. Yo and draw through the first two loops on the hook.
- 4. Yo and draw through the remaining two loops on the hook.

Tunisian Knit Stitch (tks)

This stitch resembles the knit stitch in knitting and creates a soft and stretchy fabric.

- 1. Insert the hook into the first stitch of the previous row.
- 2. Yarn over (yo) the hook and pull up a loop.
- 3. Yo again and draw through the first two loops on the hook.

4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 until you have reached the desired width of your fabric.

Tunisian crochet is a versatile and rewarding craft that allows you to create beautiful and unique fabrics. 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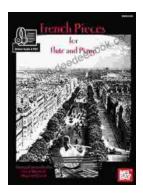
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
